



DESERT OF FLORIDA PRINCE HALL SHRINERS

SB-7050 3PVRO Fines

This paragraph does not apply to persons who only solicit applications and do not collect or handle voter registration applications.

Beginning November 6, 2024 – \$50,000.00 fine for each felon collecting or handling forms on behalf of the organization

- ✓ An organization must confirm that each volunteer is a Citizen and never convicted of a felony
- ✓ For any forms collected, the organization must provide a receipt to the applicant that contains Name of applicant, party affiliation, county of residence, name of the 3rd party organization, name of person collecting the application
- ✓ All applications must be delivered within 10 days but not after book closing for the ensuing election

Fines for late delivery

\$50 per each day late up to \$2,500

A fine of \$2,500 if found to have been willfully acted

After book closing fines

\$100 per day each day late up to \$5,000

A fine of \$5,000 if found to have been willfully acted

Not delivered to the applicant's county of residence

\$500 per each application up to \$2,500

A fine of \$5,000 if found to have been willfully acted

Maximum yearly fines - \$250,00

The Secretary may waive fines for failure to deliver promptly due to force majeure (act of God)

Altering applications without applicant knowledge or consent

A fine of \$5,000 for each application altered

Copying of application to capture personal information

3rd degree felony

If the Secretary believes the person has committed a violation, the secretary may refer the matter to the Attorney General

Pre-filled applications (retroactive as of July 1, 2023)

A fine of \$50 for each application
