

DCGD Veterans Project

During Desert Conference Gala Day 2026, with the approval of Deputy of the Desert, HPIP Louis T. Harper (08), and Deputy for the Desert, HPIC Bertha L. Baker (96), the Desert of Florida Temples, Courts, Nobles, and Daughters will collectively support two local Veterans Programs by donating needed items to each of them.

The chosen organizations:

HUD-VASH (Housing and Urban Development-Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing), a joint effort by HUD and VA that assists veterans who are at-risk of becoming homeless or homeless with rental assistance and intensive case management to help them find and keep permanent housing, connecting them with healthcare, mental health, and other services to improve their lives.

Tallahassee Veterans Village, a transitional housing program for homeless veterans, is managed by Volunteers of America of Florida, offering supportive services like case management, job training, and counseling to help veterans achieve independence.

Each Temple and Court is asked to bring a minimum of 10 to 15 items from the list below to be presented to representatives from each organization at the end of the parade on Saturday, May 30th, as a joint charitable effort and collective donation from the Desert of Florida.

a transitional housing program for homeless veterans, managed by **Volunteers of America of Florida**, providing supportive services, job training, and counseling.


